About 10km on R71 to a 4-way stop at Tarentaalrand, delegates will take the off-ramp to the left, and again about 800metres, turn right on the road heading to the East of Tzaneen, that is the road to Giyani. Those travelling from Phalaborwa Airport will also take the R71 road to Tzaneen. At Tarentaalrand 4-way stop, delegates will take the off-ramp to the right and within 800m turn right on the Giyani road. About 3 minutes drive, the Karibu Hotel entrance road is on the right.
