A TRAINING COURSE FOR PRACTISING LEXICOGRAPHERS AFRILEX-SALEX'98

At the closure of SALEX '97, which was organised by the Dictionary Unit for South African English, a mandate was given to AFRILEX to organise a follow-up course in September 1998.

This course is scheduled to take place from **7 to 18 September 1998** at the **University of Pretoria**. It is envisaged that intensive training in the compilation of *bilingual dictionaries* will be given during the first week (7 – 11 September 1998) by Sue Atkins and Michael Rundell. The second week (14 – 18 September 1998) will be dedicated to training in dictionary compilation in

African languages. The focus will be on problematic aspects of lemmatisation in African languages, on spelling variation, on electronic corpora, on technical terms, etc.
