COVID-19 Protocols for Stellenbosch University's hosting of AFRILEX 2022

Stellenbosch University has an ethical responsibility to act in the best interest of its staff, students, guests and the broader community and act with social solidarity. There is also a legal requirement to create a safe working and campus environment.

A person must, when entering and being inside an indoor public place, wear a face mask. A mask is no longer a requirement for outside. A *face mask* means a cloth face mask or a homemade item that covers the nose and mouth, or another appropriate item to cover the nose and mouth.

For any indoor or outdoor gathering, a maximum of 50% of the venue capacity may be occupied, provided that every attendee must: (a) be vaccinated against COVID-19 and produce a valid vaccination certificate; or (b) produce a valid certificate of a negative COVID-19 test, recognised by the World Health Organization, which was obtained not more than 72 hours before the date of the gathering.

All individuals entering the venue are screened (preferably before they travel to the venue) – you may use the higher health screening tools [webform: healthcheck.higherhealth.ac.za] to enable screening. No one with symptoms may attend a gathering.
